An Ordinance relating to the Water Department Fund; Declaring an emergency and appropriating money by reason thereof;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF YACOLT:

SECTION 1.

Due to the need of extending the Water line to service new residence being built within the City limits, and due to the Expense of the material for same, an emergency is found to exist, and an emergency is hereby declared to exist.

SECTION 2.

The estimated amount to meet this emergency is three thousand, five hundred sixty-four Dollars and ninety-seven cents (\$3,564,97) and that part of the Water Budget pertaining to cumulative reserve fund shall therefore be decreased by Three Thousand, Five Hundred Sixty-four Dollars and Ninety-seven cents (\$3,564.97) and that part of the Water Budget pertaining to materials shall be increased by Three Thousand, Five Hundred Sixty-four Dollars and ninety-seven cents (\$3,564.97).

SECTION 3.

This Ordinance shall become effective after it's passage by the Council of the Town of Yacolt, and posting as according to law.
