Ordinance No. 19

An ordinance to specify and adopt the system or plan proposed for a municipal water system for the town of Yacolt and declare the estimated cost thereof as near as may be; and direct that the said system shall be submitted for ratification or objection to the qualified voters of said town at a special election therefore within the town of Yacolt, at which election, also, to submit to the said voters the question of borrowing \$6000⁰⁰ by the said town of Yacolt for strictly municipal purposes;

Whereas, it is deemed by the City Council of Yacolt, Washington, prudent and necessary to provide for a municipal water plant, and also provide the money necessary to pay for the same, and,

Whereas, the city council have had a survey made and plans and specifications prepared by an engineer for that purpose and,

Whereas, it is necessary in order to secure the said water plant by the said town that the town borrow the sum of 6000⁰⁰ which sum being in excess of the amount, the said council is authorized to borrow, and

Whereas, it is necessary to submit same to a vote of the people of said town;

Now therefore, be it ordained by the council of the town of Yacolt:

Section 1

That the town of Yacolt shall provide a Municipal water plant by gravity system, according to the plans and specifications now on file with the clerk of said council.

Section 2.

That the plans and specifications are hereby approved and adopted as the plans and specifications for the said municipal water plant and system of the town of Yacolt.

Section 3

The said council does hereby declare that the estimated cost of said water system as near as may be determined is the sum of Six Thousand Dollars.

Section 4

That the said system, or plant, proposed, shall be submitted for ratification or rejection to the qualified voters of the said town of Yacolt of which thirty days notice shall be given in the Yacolt

Bulletin, the newspaper during the town printing, by publication in each issue of said paper during said time, and by pasting notice at place of voting or polling place for same time.

Section 5.

That a special city election is hereby called to be held at the usual place of voting in the town of Yacolt, Clarke County, State of Washington, on Tuesday the 17th day of May, 1910, in the manner provided by the general election laws, so far as the same are applicable thereto, at which election shall be submitted the question whether or not the said system, or plan for Municipal water works shall be ratified or rejected by the town of Yacolt, and there shall also be submitted at the same time of election the further question as to whether or not the town of Yacolt shall borrow the money in the sum aforesaid, and incur the indebtedness aforesaid for the purpose aforesaid.

Section 6.

The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed forthwith to give notice of the said special election, as hereinafter provided

and to prepare the ballots for said election and distribute the same to the officers of the said election at the proper time.

Section 7.

At said election the ballots shall read as follows, to-wit:

"For adoption of system, proposed, yes" for those in favor of adopting the same; and "For rejection of system, no," for those in favor of rejecting the same. At said election the ballots shall read as follows, to-wit: "Bonds, yes" for those in favor of borrowing said sum, and "Bonds, no" for those voting against the same.

Section 8

Officers of said election are hereby appointed as follows to-wit:
Judges: E. A. Eaton and O. P. Lowe
and Robt Lowe.

Section 9

The material of said election shall be published for 30 days in the Yacolt Bulletin in each publication during the said time immediately preceding the said election.

Section 10

This ordinance shall be in force from and after its passage and publication in one issue

in the said Yacolt Bulletin

ORDINANCE 19

AN ORDINANCE TO SPECIFY AND ADOPT THE SYSTEM OR PLAN PROPOSED FOR A MUNICIPAL WATER SYSTEM FOR THE TOWN OF YACOLT AND DECLARE THE ESTMATED COST THEREOF AS NEAR AS MAY BE; AND DIRECT THAT THAT SAID SYSTEM SHALL BE SUBMITTED FOR RATIFICATION OR OBJECTION TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF SAID TOWN AT A SPECIAL ELECTION THEREFORE WITHIN THE TOWN OF YACOLT, AT WHICH ELECTION, ALSO, TO SUBMIT TO THE SAID VOTERS THE QUESTION OF BORROWING \$6000.00 BY THE SAID TOWN OF YACOLT FOR STRICTLY MUNICIPAL PURPOSES.

Whereas, it is deemed by the city council of Yacolt, Washington prudent and necessary to provide for a municipal water plant, and also provide the money necessary to pay for the same, and,

Whereas, the city council have had a survey made and plans and specifications prepared by and engineer for that purpose and,

Whereas, it is necessary in order to secure the said water plant by the said town that the town borrow the sum of \$6000.00 which sum being in excess of the amount, the said council is authorized to borrow, and

Whereas, it is necessary to submit same to a vote of the people of said town;

Now therefore be it ordained by the council of the town of Yacolt:

Section 1. That the Town of Yacolt shall provide a municipal water plant by gravity system, according to the plans and specifications now on file with the clerk of said council.

Section 2. That the plans and specifications are hereby approved and adopted as the plans and specifications for the said municipal water plant and system of the Town of Yacolt.

Section 3. The said council does hereby declare that the estimated cost of said water system as mean may be determined is the sum of six thousand dollars.

Section 4. That the said system, or plant, proposed shall be submitted for ratification or rejection to the qualified voters of the said town of Yacolt of which thirty days notice shall be given in the Yacolt Bulletin, the newspaper doing the town printing, but publication in each issue of said paper during said time, and by posting notice at place of voting or polling place for same time.

Section 5. That a special city election is hereby called to be held at the usual place of voting in the town of Yacolt, Clark County, State of Washington, on Tuesday the 17th day of May, 1910, in the manner provided by the general election laws, so for as the same are applicable thereto, at which election shall be submitted the question whether or not the said system, or plan for municipal water works shall be ratified or rejected by the town of Yacolt, and there shall also be submitted at the same time of election the further question as to whether or not the town of Yacolt shall borrow the money in the sum aforesaid, and incur the indebtedness aforesaid for the purpose aforesaid.

Section 6. The city clerk is hereby authorized and directed forthwith to give notice of the said special election, as hereinafter provided and to prepare the ballots for said election and distribute the same to the office of the said election at the proper time.

Section 7. All said election the ballots shall read as follows:

“For adoption of system, proposed, yes” for those in favor of adopting the same; and “For rejection of system, no” for those in favor of rejecting the same. At said election the ballots shall read as follows, “Bonds, yes” for those in favor of borrowing said sum, and “bonds, no” for those voting against the same.

Section 8. Officers of said election are hereby appointed as follows;

Judges: EA Eaton and PP Lower and Robert Lower

Section 9. The notice of said election shall be published for 30 days the Yacolt Bulletin in each publication during the said time immediately preceding the said election.

Section 10. This ordinance shall be in force from and after it's passage and publication in one issue in the said Yacolt Bulletin.

Read first and second times April 13, 1910 and read third time and passed unanimously the same day. Published April 16, 1910
