ORDINANCE NO. 197

AN ORDINANCE establishing and adopting elected officials' salaries.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Yacolt, Washington, are in regular session this _____day of February, 1979, and

WHEREAS, the members of the Town Council have had notice of the time, place and purpose of the meeting of said council, now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF YACOLT, WASHINGTON, as follows:

Section 1. Salary Schedule. The following salaries shall be the salaries of the following elected officials for the year January 1 to December 31st of the following years:

Said salaries shall be paid each elected official as shown in the above schedule.

Section 2. Certain elected officials excepted. Notwithstanding Section 1, no elected official, or replacement therefor, serving in a current term of office as of the effective
date of the ordinance codified in this chapter shall have the
benefit or advantage of the salary schedule shown in Section 1
until after the beginning of a new term which starts after
the effective date of the ordinance codified in this chapter;

provided, that any elected official who is not eligible				
to receive any of the increases shown in Section 1, but				
who was eligible to receive any increase shown in Ordinance				
shall receive the salary shown for said elected official in				
Ordinance No as long as the elected official is				
eligible to receive any salary set forth in this chapter.				
Section 3. Prior ordinance. To the extent that				
this ordinance is in conflict with the provisions of Ordinance				
No, the provisions of this ordinance shall prevail.
