

An ordinance declaring an emergency and providing for necessary funds to pay for the construction of and maintaining of a fire alarm system; and for the purchase of a building for fire equipment and fire dept. use and other town equipment.

That there was not budgeted sufficient funds for the fire dept. and general fund to purchase and maintain a fire alarm system that is v very definately needed as we do not now have an adequate system, and to purchase a building for fire equipment as we do not now have a building to house said equipment due to events unforeseen.

That this emergency is one which could not reasonably been forseen at the time of making the budget for 1969 and it is to the best interest of the Town of Yacolt that said emergency be relieved. At the time of preparing the budget for 1969 we were using the Weyerhaeuser building to garage our fire-fighting equipment and other equipment. Since that time the building has been sold and we have had to vacate. The fire alarm reporting has been handled by two individuals in the town and it is now understood that they would like to be relieved of this fire reporting leaving the town with no system.

That in order to relieve said emergency, it is hereby ordained that the Town of Yacolt pay a sum sufficient and adequate for said emergency Namely \$475.00 for the purpose of maintaining the fire alarm system for the remainder of the year 1969, and \$950.00 for the purchase of the State Dept. of Natural Resources building at 404 S. Parcel at \$500.00 down and approximately \$50.00 per month for the remainder of the year 1969. A Total of \$1,425.00.
