ORDINANCE NO. 156

AN ORDINANCE Calling for a Special Election to Vote on Excess Levy for Purpose of Acquiring Fire, Plice, Park, and Street Equipment.

THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF YACOLT, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Ι

That it will be necessary to acquire for the Town of Yacolt fire, and police equipment for the current fund, park equipment for the park fund, and street equipment and/or the maintenance thereof for the street fund; that in order to raise funds sufficient to pay for the same it is necessary to have an excess levy of 15 mill for the of Five Thousand Three Hundred Seventy-Six and 21/100 Dollars (\$5,376.21).

II

That a special election be called to be held on the 17th day of September, 1968, to enable the citizens of the Town of Yacolt to vote on the proposition for an excess levy for 1969 to pay for said equipment. That the Clerk of Yacolt be instructed to cause notice to be given as required by law of said election.

III

This ordinance will be deemed to be in full force and effect after its passage and publication according to law.
