

AN ORDINANCE adopting the budget for the calendar year 1972.

THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF YACOLT, WASHINGTON DOES ORDAIN  
AS FOLLOWS:

I.

That pursuant to Chapter 95, Laws of 1969, Ex.
