AN ORDINANCE of the Town of Yacolt, Washington, specifying and adopting a plan for the acquisition, construction and installation of certain additions and improvements to and extensions of the water supply and distribution system of the Town, declaring the estimated cost thereof, authorizing the issuance of water revenue warrants in the principal amount of not to exceed \$230,600 for the purpose of providing part of the funds necessary to acquire, construct and install such additions, improvements and extensions; and authorizing the issuance of water revenue bonds of the town in the principal sum of \$230,600 for the purpose of retiring such water revenue warrants after the completion of the construction and installation of such additions, improvements and extensions.

WHEREAS, the water supply and distribution system of the Town is in need of certain additions, improvements and extensions in order to provide the Town with an adequate supply of water; and

WHEREAS, in order to pay part of the cost of such additions, improvements and extensions, it is deemed necessary that the Town issue and sell its water revenue warrants in the principal sum of not to exceed \$230,600; and

WHEREAS, in order to retire such water revenue warrants upon the substantial completion of the construction and installation of such additions, improvements and extensions, it is deemed necessary that the town issue and sell its water revenue bonds in the principal sum of \$230,600.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Yacolt, Washington, as follows:

<u>Section</u> 1. The following plan for the acquisition, construction and installation of additions and improvements to and extensions of the water system of the Town of Yacolt is hereby adopted.

(a) Develop the existing well located at the Town park, construct a housing structure for the wellhead piping and controls, and tie the well into the distribution system with a 6" pipeline. (b) Construct a 500,000 gallon prestressed concrete reservoir to be located on a 200' x 400' site approximately 1200' west of the intersection of Humphrey Street and the easterly boundary of Section 3, Township 4 North, Range 3 East.

(c) Construct a 12"waterline from the existing well to the reservoir.

(d) Construct a 12" main from the existing well to the school and install a fire hydrant at the school.
(e) Install a small booster pump station to provide water service to high elevation residences, to be located on the south edge of Weaver Creek Road near the center of Section 1 of Township 4 North, Range 3 East, W.M. and along

the existing 8" line.

(f) Drill a stand-by well to provide back-up water supply, to be located in Lot 7, Block 4, Fifth Addition to Yacolt.
(g) Disconnect the transmission line from the Big Tree
Creek Dam and Reservoir at the existing chlorinator.

(h) Install approximately 200 water meters.

(i) Remove and relocate the existing pressure reducing valve.

The aforesaid additions and improvements to and extensions of the water supply and distribution system of the Town shall be connected one to the other and to the existing system so as to make a complete utility, and such additions, improvements and extensions shall be complete with all valves, fittings, saddles, and all other appurtenances required for the complete function thereof.

The Town shall acquire all material and equipment, real or personal property, or interest therwin, easements, franchises, and rights of way necessary to carry out the above--described plan.

It is hereby further provided that such plan shall be subject to such additions and changes as to detail or other changes not affecting the main general plan hereinbefore set forth as may be authorized by the Town Council, either prior to or during the actual course of construction.

<u>SECTION</u> B. The estimated cost of acquiring, constructing and installing such additions and improvements to and extensions of the water supply and distribution system of the Town is hereby declared to be, as near as may be, the sumo of \$386,000, which cost shall be provided from cash now in the Water System Construction Fund of the Town form grants

from the United States and/or the State of Washington, and from the sale of water revenue warrants of the town in the principal sum of not to exceed \$230,600.

As an integral part of the plan for acquering, constructing and installing such additions and improvements to and extensions of such water supply and distribution system, the Town shall issue and sell such water revenue warrants in such amounts and at such time or times as the Town Council may determine to be to the best interests of the Town. The exact date or dates, form, terms, unturities and covenants of such warrants shall be as hereafter fixed by ordinance or ordinances of the Town.

SECTION 3. As a further integral part of such plan, upon the substant ial competion of the construction and installation of such additions, improvements and extensions the Town shall issue and sell water revenue bonds of the Town in the principal amount of \$230,600 for the purpose of providingthe funds to retire such water revenue warrants. The bonds shall be sold in such amounts and at such time or times as the Town Council may determine to be in the best interest of the Town. The exact form, date, terms, and maturities and covenants of such bonds shall be as hereafter fixed by ordinance or resolution of the Town. <u>SECTION</u> 4. The action of the Town Council and Town officials in calling for bids for the acquisition, construction and installation of the additions, improvements and extensions described in Section 1 of this ordinance is hereby in all respects ratified and confirmed.

SECTION 3. As a further integral part of such plan, upon the substant ial competion of the construction and installation of such additions, improvements and extensions the Town shall issue and sell water revenue bonds of the Town in the principal amount of \$230,600 for the purpose of providing the funds to retire such water revenue warrants. The bonds shall be sold in such amounts and at such time or times as the Town Council may determine to be in the best interest of the Town. The exact form, date, terms, and maturities and covenants of such bonds shall be as hereafter fixed by ordinance or resolution of the Town. <u>SECTION</u> 4. The action of the Town Council and Town officials in calling for bids for the acquisition, construction and installation of the additions, improvements and extensions described in Section 1 of this ordinance is hereby in all respects ratified and confirmed.
