

ORDINANCE NO. 170

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE BUDGET FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 1973.

THE TOWN COUNCIL OF YACOLT, WASHINGTON DOES ORADIN AS FOLLOWS:
