AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF YACOLT AMENDING ORDINANCE #181

5.2.2. ALL NEW APPLICANTS SHALL MAKE A CASH DEPOSIT.

All new applicants shall make cash deposit with the water department to secure payment of bills. The deposit shall be \$50.00, or a sum equal to the estimated bill for two billing periods, which ever one is greater.

11.7 DELINQUENT ACCOUNTS.

An account becomes delinquent after thirty (30) days. A delinquent account notice will be sent with the next current billing. The notice shall state the date of turn off. The turn off date will be approximately forty (40) days after the first day of month, of the delinquent month.

11.7.2 TURN OFF NOTICE SHALL BE DELETED.

11.7.3 SERVICE TURN ON

On the turn off date the Meter Reader or other agent will turn off the water \$:AM and install a padlock to prohibit unauthorized water turn on. The water will not be turned on until all delinquent accounts have been paid.
