

AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 209

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 209 CALLING FOR AN EMERGENCY IN ORDER TO REDUCE THE SPEED LIMIT FROM THE LEGALLY POSTED SPEED TO FIFTEEN (15) MILES PER HOUR IN THE EVENT OF EMERGENCY ROAD CONDITIONS.

WHEREAS, THE TOWN COUNCIL OF YACOLT WASHINGTON ARE OF THE OPINION THAT IT WOULD BE IN THE BEST PUBLIC INTEREST TO INCLUDE ROAD CONDITIONS AND THE DETERIORATION OF ANY AND ALL ROADS WITHIN THE TOWN LIMITS, TO SAID ORDINANCE.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

IT IS HEREBY DECLARED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF YACOLT, WASHINGTON, THAT AN EMERGENCY ALSO EXISTS WHEN AND IF THE ROADS WITHIN THE TOWN ARE DETERIORATING AND ARE IN NEED OF REPAIR AS TO WARRANT THE REDUCTION IN SPEED TO FIFTEEN (15) MILES PER HOUR. THIS EMERGENCY WOULD REMAIN IN EFFECT UNTIL SUCH A TIME AS TO THE COMPLETION OF ROAD REPAIR AND THE DETERIORATION OF THE ROADS HAS CEASED.
