

ORDINANCE #288

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING ON STREET PARKING REGULATIONS IN THE TOWN OF YACOLT, WASHINGTON, ADDITION TO WASHINGTON STATE MODEL TRAFFIC ORDINANCE #281, ADOPTED OCTOBER 7, 1986:

WHEREAS: The Town Council of Yacolt, Washington is in regular session this 17 day of February 1987: and

WHEREAS: all members of the Town Council have had notice of the time, place and purpose of the meeting of said Council: and

WHEREAS: The Town Council members are of opinion that it would be in the best interest for the Town to adopt this Ordinance:

DUE TO VEHICLES BEING PARKED IMPROPERLY, AND FOR LONG PERIODS OF TIME:

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it hereby ordained by the Town Council of Yacolt, Washington, as follows:

SECTION I. It shall be unlawful to park in, no Parking Zones, Bus Zones, or on South side of West Yacolt Road, from Amboy Avenue West to Johnson Avenue.

SECTION LL. Parking will be limited to thirty (30) minutes during the hours of 7:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. on the North side of West Yacolt Road from the West edge of Railroad Property to the Fire Hydrant. "The area in front of the Post Office."

SECTION lll. Parking will be limited to two (2) hours on the North side of West Yacolt Road from Amboy Avenue West to Blackmore Avenue during the hours of 7:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.

SECTION lV. No parking or standing will be permitted on Hubbard Avenue at any time from East Yacolt Road to Railroad Avenue.

This Ordinance shall be in effect after its passage and Publication according to Law.
