d. Amount budgeted for Public Utilities be decreased from $\$ 3500$ to $\$ 3540$
e. Amount budgeted for Capitol Outlay be increased from $\$ 3000$ to $\$ 5200$

AMBLULANCE FUND:
a. Amount budgeted for Salaries be decreased from $\$ 52,470$ to $\$ 49,970$
b. Amount budgeted for Projects be decreased from $\$ 28,366$ to $\$ 22,366$
C. Amount budgeted for Supplies be increased from $\$ 24,181$ to 26,681
D. Amount budgeted for Repairs \& Maintenance be increased from $\$ 10,097$ to $\$ 15,097$
e. Amount budgeted for Capitol Outlay be increased from $\$ 20,900$ to $\$ 21,900$
