ORDINANCE #389

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE BUDGET FOR THE TOWN OF YACOLT, WASHINGTON, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2000.

WHEREAS, the budget committee of the Town of Yacolt, Washington completed and placed on file with the Town Clerk/Treasurer a proposed budget and estimate of the amount of the moneys required to meet the public expenses, bond retirement and interest, reserve funds and expenses of government of the Town of Yacolt for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2000, and a notice was published that the Council of the Town of Yacolt would meet on the 6th day of December, 1999 at the hour of 7:00 p.m., at the council chambers in the town hall of the Town of Yacolt for the purpose of making and adopting a budget for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2000 and giving taxpayers within the limits of the Town of Yacolt an opportunity to be heard upon said budget; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Yacolt Council did meet at said time and place and did then consider the matter of said proposed budget; and

WHEREAS, the said proposed budget does not exceed the lawful limit of taxation allowed by law to be levied on the property within the Town of Yacolt for the purposes set forth in said budget, and the estimated expenditures set forth in said budget being all necessary to carry on the government of the Town of Yacolt for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2000 and being sufficient to meet the various needs of the Town of Yacolt during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2000.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Council of the Town of Yacolt do ordain as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> The budget for the Town of Yacolt, Washington, for the year 2000 is hereby adopted at the fund level in its final form and content as set forth in the document entitled <u>Town of Yacolt 2000 Budget</u>, 3 copies of which are on file in the Office of the Clerk/Treasurer.

<u>Section 2.</u> Estimated resources, including fund balances or working capital for each separate fund of the Town of Yacolt, and aggregate totals (net of transactions between funds) for all such funds combined, for the year 2000 are set forth in summary form below, and are hereby appropriated for expenditure at the fund level during the year 2000 as set forth below:
