

ORDINANCE #351

An Ordinance relating to traffic control devices and stop signs within the Town limits of Yacolt, Washington.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Yacolt, Washington is in regular session this 7th day of February, 1994 and

WHEREAS, each member of the Council has had notice of the time, place and purpose of this matter: and

WHEREAS, in order to comply with Traffic Control Devices under the laws of the State of Washington, the Council finds that it is in the public interest to adopt this Ordinance; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED AND RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF YACOLT, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Traffic Control Devices.

The provisions of Chapter 47.36 RCW entitled "Traffic Control Devices" is incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. Location of Stop Signs.

The location of the stop signs within the Corporate limits of the Town of Yacolt, Washington, two additional stop signs at N. Amboy Ave. and W. Yacolt Rd. . One additional stop sign at N. Railroad Ave. and W. Yacolt Rd. .

Section 3. Meddling With Signs Prohibited.

No person shall without lawful authority attempt to or in fact alter, deface, injure, knock-down, or remove any official traffic control signal, traffice device, rail-road sign or signal, or any inscription, shield or insignia thereon, or any other part there of.

Section 4. Penalty.

Any person who shall violate the terms and conditions or sections of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a Civil fine not to exceed

Section 5. Adoption

This Ordinance is adopted this 7th day of February 1994.
