

ORDINANCE #435

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO TRAFFIC CALMING DEVICES.

WHEREAS: The Town Council of Yacolt, Washington, is in regular session this 2nd day of August, 2004; and

WHEREAS: All members of the Town Council have had notice of time, place, and purpose of said meeting; and

WHEREAS: The Town Council is of the opinion that it would be in the best interest for the Town to adopt this Ordinance; and

NOW THEREFORE: BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF YACOLT, WASHINGTON, as follows:

SECTION 1: Requirements.

To be eligible for installation of a Town approved traffic calming device, a street must meet the following two qualifications:

1. It must be classified as an access, local, or collector street, as defined in the Town of Yacolt Engineering Standards For Public Works Construction.
2. It must have an identified speeding problem as observed by neighborhood residents and verified by the Public Works Supervisor.

SECTION 2: Approved Traffic Calming Devices.

1. Portable GNR Speed Bumps. Portable GNR speed bumps are used to slow vehicle speeds. They are used in series to reduce speeds along a section of street.

The Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption and publication according to law.
