## **ORDINANCE #435**

## AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO TRAFFIC CALMING DEVICES.

WHEREAS: The Town Council of Yacolt, Washington, is in regular session this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of August, 2004; and

WHEREAS: All members of the Town Council have had notice of time, place, and purpose of said meeting; and

WHEREAS: The Town Council is of the opinion that it would be in the best interest for the Town to adopt this Ordinance; and

NOW THEREFORE: BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF YACOLT, WASHINGTON, as follows:

## **SECTION 1:** Requirements.

To be eligible for installation of a Town approved traffic calming device, a street must meet the following two qualifications:

- It must be classified as an access, local, or collector street, as defined in the Town of Yacolt Engineering Standards For Public Works Construction.
- 2. It must have an identified speeding problem as observed by neighborhood residents and verified by the Public Works Supervisor.

## **SECTION 2:** Approved Traffic Calming Devices.

 Portable GNR Speed Bumps. Portable GNR speed bumps are used to slow vehicle speeds. They are used in series to reduce speeds along a section of street.

The Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption and publication according to law.
