WHWREAS;

There has, in the past, been no set policy of the Town of Yacolt regarding vacations and sick-leave for employees, either elective or appointive, of the Town, and

WHEREAS;

A definite policy regarding vacations and sick-leave would be of benefit to all concerned.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED;

That the following rules be considered the Official Policy of the Council of the Town of Yacolt;

- 1. A paid vacation of one week per year be granted to all employees after twelve months of continuous service to the Town.
- 2. A paid vacation of two weeks per year be granted to all employees after five years of continuous service to the Town.
- 3. A maximum leave of ten days, without loss of salary, be granted all employees who cannot perform their duties due to sickness or injury or death in their immediate family.
- 4. Vacations and/or sick-leave cannot be acculumated from one year to the next.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED :

That this policy shall become effective January 1, 1963.
