

WHEREAS;

Due to the opening of a large new industry in Northern Clark County a need for new housing is foreseen in the Yacolt area and,

WHEREAS;

Douglas Lowell Inc., a building contractor, has indicated intentions of constructing some fifty new homes within the Town of Yacolt and,

WHEREAS;

In order to secure F.H.A. financing, the streets serving these new homes must meet certain specifications, namely, a hard surfaced street of twenty foot width and,

WHEREAS;

The building contractor has asked the Town Council for a statement concerning the improvement of these streets.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF YACOLT;

That a sum of \$7,500.00 be set aside for the purpose of developing the following streets;

- Yacolt Ave. from Railroad Ave. to Parcel St.
- Wilson Ave. from Ranck St. to Parcel St.
- Humphrey St. from Parcel St. to Amboy St.
- Jones St. from Railroad Ave. to Blackmore St.
- Cushman St. from Parcel St. to Blackmore St.
- Ranck St. from Cushman St. to Wilson Ave.
- Blackmore St. from Jones St. to Cushman St.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED;

That immediate steps be taken to secure estimates of the cost of the proposed development, and if said estimates prove to be satisfactory to the Council and the Contractor the Council will, after a definite commitment by the Contractor of enough funds to insure completion of the project, take the necessary steps to see that the project is initiated and completed.
