

RESOLUTION

107

WHEREAS, The Weaver Creek Road, on the outskirts of Yacolt, has changed, by repeated travel by its users over a route of less resistance, and

WHEREAS, The roadway now used lies directly on top of the main water line running from Big Creek to Yacolt, and

WHEREAS, Continued use of this roadway as it now exists could result in serious damage to the Yacolt water supply.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Town of Yacolt ask the County Commissioners to have the present Weaver Creek Road, from Falls Road to Weaver Creek, restored to its original route.
