

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS:

The portion of the funds received by the Town of Yacolt, from its regular sources of revenue, available to the Street Department are not sufficient to enable the Town Council to continue its Street Improvement program.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That a proposition be put before the voters of the Town of Yacolt requesting a 15 mill levy be assessed against the taxable property within the Town. Proceeds of said levy to be used for the improvement of streets.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

That the above mentioned proposition be put before the voters at the General Election to be held November 6, 1956.
