

RESOLUTION #262

A Resolution placing an excess levy of \$1.05 per thousand on the November ballot. The proceeds of the levy are to be used for Repair and Maintenance of the Streets of Yacolt.

Whereas: The Council of the Town of Yacolt desires to maintain the public roads within the Town in the best condition possible, and

Whereas: The Council, having reviewed both present Revenues and Expenditures and projected (1987) Revenues finds that sufficient funds will not be available to maintain the roads in adequate condition and,

Whereas: The Council desires to give the voters of the town of Yacolt an opportunity to vote on the provision of funds to help maintain their roads,

THEREFORE: be it Resolved by the Council of the Town of Yacolt that the November 1986 ballot in the Town contain the following question: shall the Town of Yacolt impose an excess levy of \$1.05 per thousand dollars, of assessed valuation for the 1987 year only: proceeds to be used for the Repair and Maintenance of the Streets for Yacolt.

Passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor this 2 day of September, 1986.
