WHEREAS, an emergency has arisen due to the shortage of water
in the Town of Yacolt, and

WHEREAS, it becomes necessary to require the residents of the
town to curtail water, and

WHEREAS, prior notices to curtail water have been disregarded,
THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, in order to have enough water to
supply the town, it becomes necessary to put on certain
restrictions,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that anyone using water unnecessarily
shall be subject to penalties of either shut-off water
to the home and/or a fine not to exceed (\$500.00) Five
Hundred Dollars, until further notice.

This policy shall become effective July 19, 1980.
