

RESOLUTION #384

A RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING THE WEEK OF APRIL 12 THROUGH APRIL 18 AS 2004 NATIONAL COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT WEEK.

WHEREAS: the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program was established to develop urban communities by providing decent housing, a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low and moderate income, and

WHEREAS: the week of April 12 – April 18, 2004, has been designated as National Community Development Week and as the 30th Anniversary of the CDBG program. The Town of Yacolt, Washington is a participant in the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program which funds a myriad of social service, economic development and housing programs in this community, and

WHEREAS: in this community and in communities throughout the nation, thirty years of Community Development Block Grant program funding has developed a strong working network of relationships between this local government, residents of Community Development target neighborhoods and the many non-profit agencies which provide services and help make possible our commitment to those neighborhoods, and

WHEREAS: the Town of Yacolt recognizes that the Community Development Block Grant Program is a partnership of federal, local government, non-profit and community efforts, and that the services funded by the federal CDBG program, administered by the local government and often delivered by local non-profit organizations, rely heavily upon the dedication and goodwill of our combined efforts, and

WHEREAS: since 1985, the Town of Yacolt has received over \$759,882.62 dollars of Community Development Block Grant funds for various community development activities benefiting low and moderate income residents,


